Fair school meals - tasty & just

Around 165,000 lunches are distributed in schools all over Berlin every day. This amounts to 30 tonnes of rice, half a million bananas and many thousands of pineapples every year. The administrations of the Berlin Senate as well as some districts have worked to ensure that these products will only be sourced from certified Fair Trade since the school year of 2020/21.
